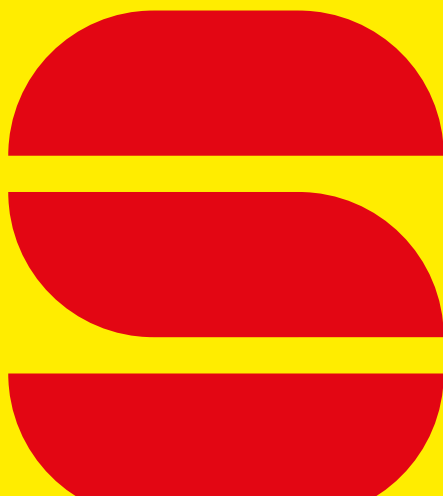

Our routes have been developed with maximum visibility in mind, with both geographically and demographically targeted runs available to meet the specific needs of all of our partners' individual campaigns.

We consider it an essential part of our service to our clients and partners that we recycle any leftover print following the successful completion of a campaign, free of charge, ensuring that their carbon footprint is as small as possible.

After each campaign is completed, we send our clients and partners a detailed report of not only which outlets and venues have received their print, but also in what quantities they were distributed, giving maximum oversight of exactly where their literature has been seen by their target audience.

● Sheffield Full Run

Our **most popular** package which includes a combination of all City Centre and South & West pick-up points, with a broad reach across the centre and south-west of the city.

Approx: 8,000 single-sheet flyers

Areas include: City Centre, Ecclesall Road, Sharrow Vale Road, Ecclesall Road South, London Road, Chesterfield Road, Woodseats, Nether Edge, Abbeydale Road, Heeley, Millhouses, Totley, Greenhill, Dore, Fulwood, Broomhill, Crookes, Crookesmoor.

● Sheffield City Centre Run

The central hub of Sheffield, hosting a wide variety of cafés, cinemas, hotels, retailers, libraries and bars. The place where workers commute and people from all walks of life pass through week in, week out. If you want your print to reach the widest variety of people, we recommend our City Centre Run.

Approx: **4,000 single-sheet flyers**

OR

2,500 multi-page brochures

Areas include: **Broomhill to the Parkway, Kelham Island to St Mary's Gate and everywhere in between, including Division Street, West Street, St Paul's Square, Campo Lane, both universities' city campuses and many more.**

● Sheffield South & West Run

Sheffield is a city of small villages. Roads like Abbeydale and Ecclesall play host to whole communities filled with bars, restaurants, libraries and retailers. Reach the wider Sheffield community with our 'Out of Town' South & West Run.

● Sheffield North-East Run

Reaching a wide range of community-focussed areas of Sheffield, situated along major tram and bus routes on the outskirts of the north-east of the city centre, including Firth Park, Burngreave and Shirecliffe, the North-East Sheffield Run engages with an audience from a rich variety of cultural backgrounds.

Areas include: **Hillsborough, Parson Cross, Firth Park, Shirecliffe, Fir Vale, Pitsmoor, Page Hall, Burngreave.**

● Sheffield East Run

Sheffield is of course known as the 'City of Villages'. This perhaps never rings more true than when it comes to the suburbs on the eastern side of the city. Covering several heavily-populated districts, the East Run is perfect for reaching an often untapped audience.

● Sheffield High Income Run

Want to target those patrons of the arts with a larger disposable income, or an older but engaged demographic who really value printed material over digital? Then the High Income Run is for you, covering areas such as Dore, Totley, Fulwood, Nether Edge and Ecclesall Road, among others.

Areas include: Ecclesall Road, Sharrow Vale Road, Ecclesall Road South, Nether Edge, Millhouses, Totley, Greenhill, Dore, Fulwood, Crosspool, Walkley.

● Sheffield Evening Run

With a cultural heritage of brass bands and heavy industry, Barnley is now in the process of regeneration, spearheaded by the presence of cultural institutions such as Barnley Civic, playing host to a variety of cross-platform arts.

● Chesterfield Run

Just down the road, Chesterfield is a well-known market town and destination choice for tourists visiting South Yorkshire. Home to Britain's largest outdoor market space, Chesterfield has a population of 70,000 and a wealth of arts organisations and independent traders. Reach a like-minded audience in Derbyshire's largest town.

Approx: 3,000 single-sheet flyers

● Doncaster Run

Only 20 miles from Sheffield, Doncaster has a population of 65,000 people and, with the recent addition of an international airport and new shopping centre, has undergone massive regeneration across the arts and education sectors.

Approx: 3,000 single-sheet flyers
OR 1,500 multi-page brochures

Areas include: High Street, Hall Gate, Cleveland Street, Princes Street, Priory Walk, Waterdale, Market Place, Sunny Bar, West Laith Gate, Baxter Gate, Nether Hall Rd, Silver Street, South Parade, St Georges Way, Church Way, Askern Road, Bentley.



● Rotherham Run

At the confluence of the River Rother and the River Don, Rotherham is located between Sheffield and Doncaster and has a population of over 117,000 people. Reach out to people who are a mere six miles from Sheffield, less than half an hour's drive away.

Approx: 2,500 single-sheet flyers
OR 1,000 multi-page brochures

Areas include: Moorgate Road, High Street, Town Centre, Mini Market, Corporation Street, Ship Hill, Main Street, Westgate, Wellgate, Catherine Street.

West Yorkshire



● Leeds Run

Often recognised as the capital of Yorkshire and the Humber, Leeds is a thriving city with an economy worth over £52 billion. Our Leeds distribution list is a blanket coverage, geographically-orientated run designed to cover main city centre spots, as well as outlying student and young professional areas, including Hyde Park, Headingley and Chapel Allerton.

● Huddersfield & Kirklees Run

As a university town with a student population of almost 20,000, Huddersfield has retained a sense of independent arts, culture and local trade, making it a popular destination with people from all of its surrounding districts in the wider Kirklees area.

Areas include: Wakefield Road, Greenhead, Westgate, The Imperial Arcade, New Street, The Byram Arcade, The Packhorse Centre, Lindley.



● Wakefield Run

Having enjoyed a recent city-wide regeneration, Wakefield now boasts a burgeoning Cultural Quarter, comprising several prestigious arts venues including The Hepworth, The Art House and the world-famous Yorkshire Sculpture Park, bringing thousands of people into the city each year.

● Mansfield Run

Covering the bustling market town situated between Sheffield and Nottingham, the Mansfield Run reaches a wide range of demographics in and around a town renowned for its own thriving theatre and arts scene. Areas include Market Square, Stockwell Gate, Westgate and Mansfield Woodhouse.
